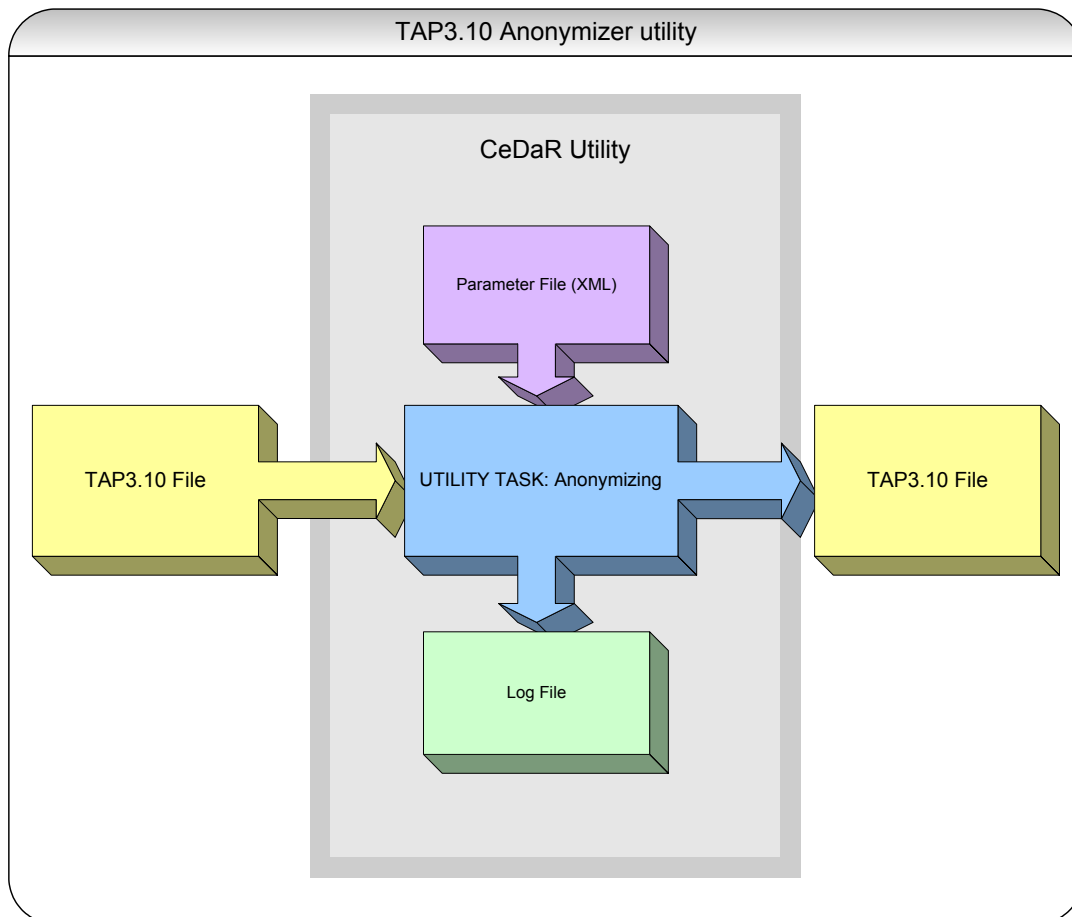


TAP3.10 Anonymizer

Description

The TAP3.10 Anonymizer replaces user specific information with neutral data in the call records, so the data sent to third party developer companies will not contain sensible data.



Benefits

In many countries it is forbidden to provide personal data of mobile subscribers to third parties. This makes it difficult to provide the necessary test files for testing newly developed CDR related applications. The **TAP3.10 Anonymizer** solves this problem by masking out user relevant parts of IMSIs, Phone Numbers and some other fields. The utility provides an easy-to-use graphical user interface and can be run from command line too. All of the following tags can be anonymized and you can specify different anonymization parameters to each field: Called Number, Calling Number, Camel Destination Number, Dialed Digits, IMEI, IMSI, MSISDN. Anonymization parameters are defined in an XML file.

Application example

If you have the phone number "239224257845" assigned to a subscriber, after the anonymization it will look like "239224299999". This ensures that your subscriber will not be recognized while the file still can be used for testing your equipment or programs.
